Temple Management Message: Embracing 2026: A message to our community

Dear Devotees,

As we conclude the year 2025, we do so with deep gratitude and humility for what our community has achieved together at Flower Mound Hindu Temple (FMHT). With your unwavering support and blessings, this year became one of meaningful progress, expanded service, and shared accomplishments.

Notable Accomplishments – 2025

This year, we reached significant milestones in our temple's growth, including a successful groundbreaking ceremony, securing city approvals, and hiring a land contractor to accelerate construction. We strengthened our operations by adding a second priest, introducing a self-pay kiosk, and implementing new accounting software for better financial oversight. Our community engagement flourished through the launch of the FMHT Cultural Society, the Baba Paduka at Home initiative, and expanded digital outreach via WhatsApp and newsletters. These achievements, supported by successful fundraising and community service like medical camps and food drives, were made possible by the collective seva and generosity of our devotees and volunteers.

Infrastructure: Completed groundbreaking and secured essential city permits.

Operations: Added a second priest and upgraded financial/payment systems.

Engagement: Launched the Cultural Society and high-reach digital communication channels.

Service: Hosted town halls, medical camps, and food drives to support the community.

What began as vision and planning has now blossomed into visible on-site construction, bringing our collective dream closer to reality than ever before.

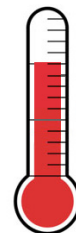

December Fundraising Highlights:

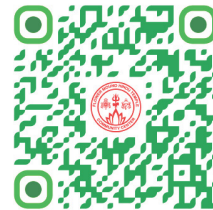

Significant Hindu Festivals in the month of January

13th January:

Bhogi and Lohri are joyous harvest festivals celebrating new beginnings, renewal, and the end of winter, with bonfires symbolizing burning away the old (negativity, old items) to welcome the new (prosperity, longer days, good harvests)

14th January:

Makara Sankranti, Pongal, Makaravilakku.

Astronomical & Seasonal: Marks the Sun's transition, ending its southern journey and beginning its northern trek (Uttarayan), signifying longer days and the arrival of spring/harvest.

Spiritual: A time for cleansing sins through holy baths, especially in rivers like the Ganga, and for prayers to the Sun God (Surya).

Agricultural: Celebrates the end of the winter harvest, with people offering thanks for new crops.

Cultural: Promotes togetherness, forgiveness, and renewal.

It is a very important day to offer prayers to ancestors (Pitru Devatas).

15th and 16th January:

Kanuma and Mukkanuma are Significant South Indian harvest festivals, the third and fourth days of Sankranti, focused on honoring cattle (cows, bulls) for their crucial role in agriculture and symbolizing gratitude to nature, fertility, and the human-animal bond.

19th January:

Auspicious Magha Masam starts.

23rd January:

Skandha Shasti. This day celebrates Lord Murugan's (Kartikeya/Subramanya) victory over the demon Surapadman, symbolizing the triumph of good over evil, righteousness over destruction, and divine wisdom over ego. On this day, in most temples, Subrahmanya Abhishekam, Archana, and Valli Devasena Subrahmanya Kalyanam are performed.

25th January:

Ratha Saptami is important as it celebrates the birth of the Sun God (Surya Jayanti), marks the start of winter's end and spring's arrival, symbolizes the Sun God's chariot journey, and is considered highly auspicious for purification, health (Arogya Saptami), and charitable acts (Daan-Punya) to remove sins and karmic debts, bringing prosperity and vitality

27th January:

Madhwa Navami honors Sri Madhwacharya's divine journey to Badri Kashrama, celebrating his devotion, teachings, and the timeless Dvaita philosophy that guides devotees toward truth and liberation.

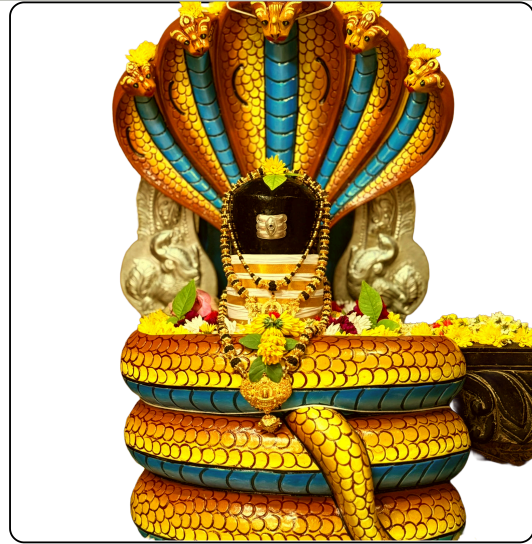

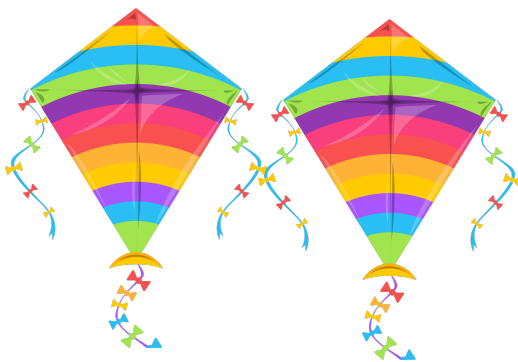

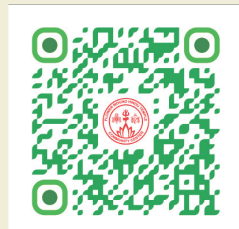

Employer Matching Contributions

Employer contribution matches for religious or charitable organizations typically depend on the specific policies of the employer's matching gift program. Here's an overview of how it usually works:

1. Check Eligibility
 - Employers usually provide a list of eligible organizations or categories, such as religious, educational, or nonprofit organizations. Some employers exclude religious organizations unless the donation is for non-religious activities like community outreach or education.
2. Donation by the Employee
 - The employee makes a personal donation to a qualifying religious or charitable organization, like a Hindu temple.
 - The donation amount should meet the employer's minimum requirements (e.g., \$25).
3. Submit Matching Gift Request
 - The employee submits a matching gift request through the company's platform or by filling out a matching gift form.
 - This could include: The donation receipt.
 - Information about the organization (e.g., tax-exempt status like 501(c)(3) in the U.S.).
 - Some companies use platforms like Benevity or Double the Donation to manage these requests.
4. Employer Verification
 - The employer verifies whether the organization and donation meet their eligibility criteria.
 - If approved, the employer matches the donation, usually up to a specified limit (e.g., \$1,000 annually).
5. Funds Disbursed
 - Once approved, the matching amount is sent directly to the organization by the employer.

Important Considerations

- Tax-Exempt Status: Most employers require the organization to have a recognized charitable status, like 501(c)(3) in the U.S.
- Restrictions on Religious Use: Some employers restrict matching to non-religious purposes, like community services or educational programs offered by the religious organization.
- Annual Caps: Employers often have an annual maximum they will match per employee.

To ensure the temple qualifies and the match is successful, check with your HR or your employer's matching gift policy.

On the auspicious occasion of **Vaikunṭha Ekādaśī**, we pray that the anugraha of **Śrī Veṅkaṭeśvara** ever remain with our children and families.

We are happy to share that we **successfully concluded** the two-day "**Kurukshetra Watch Party & 1:1 Coaching with Śikṣakāḥ**" today.

Over the course of these two days, 15 children watched six episodes of the Netflix series Kurukshetra, covering **Viśvarūpam (Bhagavad Gītā), Arjuna, Bhīṣma, Karna**, and culminating in the final episode that carries **Śrī Kṛṣṇa's message** for the times to come. Beyond the screening, the children participated in group reading sessions using the **Mahābhārata and Bhagavad Gītā** books, took notes diligently, and shared their learnings and reflections.

"**Kurukshetra Watch Party & 1 on 1 Coaching**" helped us impact 15 children (~ 30% of our three classrooms). The sincerity, focus, and enthusiasm shown by the children throughout the event were truly heartening.

A heartfelt thank-you to all the parents for their support over both days especially to those who **brought Prasadam, snacks** served as Parent **Mārgadarśakāḥ**, and **helped with clean-up**. Your seva and cooperation made this event smooth and joyful.

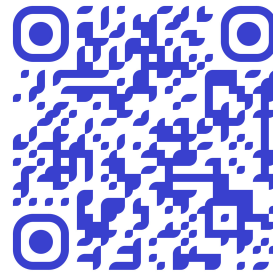

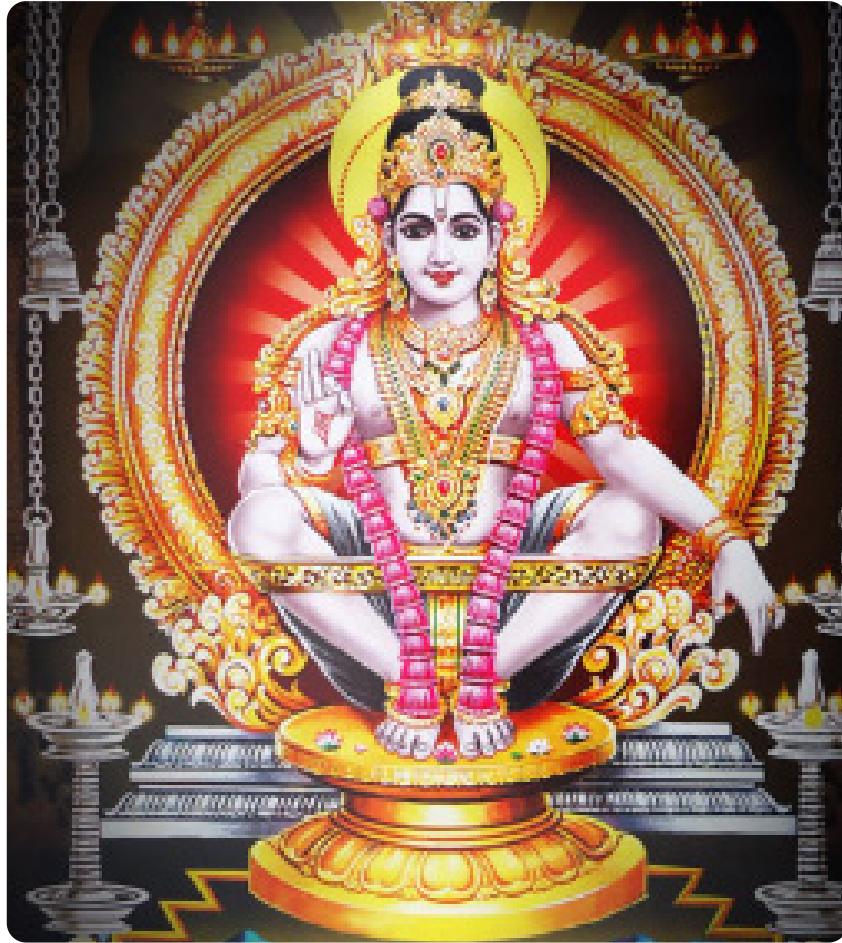
